Jobs Coming to Mocksville

Mocksville, NC - June 08, 2009 – Twenty new jobs will be coming to Ingersoll Rand in Mocksville.

Making the announcement, Terry Bralley, President of the Davie County Economic Development Commission, says that Ingersoll Rand will be investing equipment and jobs back into Ingersoll Rand's Mocksville facility. As part of the Ingersoll Rand's integrated compressor manufacturing strategy, the company has decided to move equipment from the Pueblo, Colorado Plant to their Mocksville Facility. In addition to the twenty new jobs, Ingersoll Rand will also be investing 18.5 million dollars in capital expenditures. The majority of the jobs will be highly-skilled Machine Tool Operators, associated with Helical Rotor Manufacturing. Mr. Bralley states that the move "solidifies Ingersoll Rand's commitment to reinvesting resources and jobs back into Mocksville. This is an exciting time, and we thank Ingersoll Rand for their ongoing support of our community."

The move to Mocksville will be consummated by the end of August. Personnel with specific skill sets currently working in Pueblo will be offered jobs at the Mocksville Facility.

This announcement comes on the heels of Ingersoll Rand adding about 118 jobs at the Mocksville plant, after consolidating its production operations in their Davidson, North Carolina Facility.
